- Utilize CRM and reservations platforms provided with accurate and timely data entry.
- Work with CAMO Manager to secure lodging, restaurant reservations, travel, and any other logistical piece to programs.
- Assist in updating and verifying information specific to CAMO participants and programs.
- Collect, track, and organize required participant forms promptly and accurately.
- Understand disabilities & adaptive equipment to best serve the CAMO population.
- Attend meetings, fostering positive relationships with staff.
- Availability to work during weekends and holidays as part of regular scheduling.
- Contribute to ongoing improvement of systems, policies, and program delivery through feedback and innovation.
- Other duties as assigned.
